MOTOR COACH CLEANING CHECKLIST

Put on gloves and a non-medical grade face covering before cleaning the bus
Clean bus door exterior handle and push buttons used to open door
Open overhead air vents to ensure ventilation while cleaning
Clean interior of bus door
Disinfect driver area including steering wheel, front dashboard all buttons, radio, handrails
Wipe down with disinfectant the driver chair, seat belt, arm rests
Ensure all visible garbage is removed, remove seat side bags, remove and replace garbage bags in the rear chutes
Disinfect all visible stainless-steel surfaces
Ensure lavatory supplies are fully stocked (toilet paper, hand sanitizer, garbage bags)

Disinfect all interior windows, mirrors and screens

Disinfect all tables or trays, armrests, under armrests, overhead parcel racks (door and interior) and overhead lighting

Return seat backs and footrests to upright positions and arm rests to downward position

Disinfect cup holders
Sweep entire floor area including around driver area
Mop entire floor area including around driver area
Wipe down interior entrance and stair well
Open and clean all luggage bays
Disinfect lavatory, including toilet bowl, seat, walls, mirrors, ceiling and floor. Added diligence for high touch surfaces including door handle, seat, etc. NOTE: THE BATHROOM SHOULD BE CLEANED LAST TO AVOID CROSS CONTAMINATION
Clean all the tools used to clean the coach, including the bucket, mop, rags
Remove gloves without touching hands and dispose in appropriate garbage area
Immediately go to washroom at facility and wash hands thoroughly
Put on new, clean gloves and refill all spray bottles and restore all disinfectants for next use
Sign and date attestation of cleaning checklist
